From very small private gatherings, direct committal cremations, religious services, outdoor gatherings and services on a very large scale (and everything in between) the cost will depend on the funeral you choose.

We understand that it is the unknown, that can cause additional worry, because many people are not aware what is involved when organising a funeral.

Organising a funeral takes time. There are many decisions to be made, even when the funeral is relatively simple. As funeral directors, our main role is to provide you with options, listen to what you need and carry out your wishes as planned. We are here to help, support and guide you with our knowledge and experience.

With so many decisions to make, it's important that you are aware what these choices are and how much these things cost, as you go. You need to take the time to make decisions and feel comfortable with them. You need to feel in control and be part of every decision for your loved one. Costs need to be transparent and explained so you are aware of everything before the funeral takes place.

*Our Booklet '**How Much Does a Funeral Cost**' is very comprehensive and we try to include as much as we can. Some funerals are very simple, and we have two no-service options available, and some are more detailed, where we are sourcing a range of external suppliers and professionals on your behalf.*

That's what we are here to do – to help make it easier and manage the organising and engaging of these organisations and people to help ensure the farewell for your loved one is as it should be.

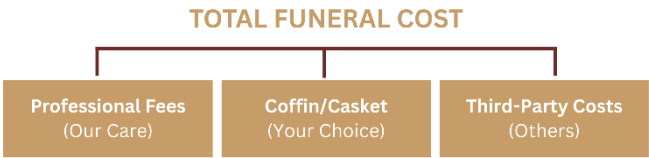


All funeral arrangements are different, so once we understand what you would like us to organise, we will provide you with a clear written estimate outlining the professional fees and any third-party costs involved.

Please note that funeral fees and disbursements can change from time to time. However, once arrangements are confirmed, we will ensure you have a clear understanding of all costs before the funeral takes place.

While there are some professional services we can recommend, based on experience and knowledge, it is all about what you choose, and we can help organise these additional services for you.

A Simple Guide to Funeral Costs



What does this mean?

Professional Fees (Our Care)

This is the fee for our time, guidance and care — looking after your loved one including care in our mortuary and preparation for viewing, supporting you through decisions, organising the arrangements and attending the funeral.

Coffin or Casket (Your Choice)

This is the coffin or casket you choose for the person you are farewelling. There are a range of options available, and you can select what feels right for you.

Third-Party Costs (Others)

These are fees charged by external providers, such as cremation or burial fees, cemetery charges, certificates, flowers, celebrants, venue hire, audio visual requests and catering.

In simple terms:

Some families choose very simple farewells, while others prefer larger gatherings with additional personal touches. We will guide you through every choice and explain costs clearly before any decisions are made. You are choosing how you would like to say goodbye, and the total cost reflects those choices.



What is a 'Professional Service Fee' and what does it include?

Every Funeral Director structure their professional service fees differently. The cost will often reflect what is included, the level of care provided, the time required to organise and conduct the funeral, and the quality of the people, vehicles, facilities and equipment entrusted with your family's care.

At T J Scott & Son, we believe families deserve personal attention, clear guidance and exceptional care from the very first phone call.

As a long-standing member of Funerals Australia, we are required to maintain professional standards across all aspects of our service, including our facilities, vehicles, equipment, care procedures and ongoing professional development.

These standards help ensure we continue to provide the highest level of care to the families who place their trust in us.

Most importantly, our care is personal.

As a smaller, family-based funeral business, wherever possible you will have one dedicated Funeral Arranger supporting you throughout the entire process — someone who is dedicated to your family, and who takes the time to understand what is important to you, personally guiding the arrangements from beginning to end. We know how important it is not to feel like 'just another number' during such a significant and emotional time.

Our assistance is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When you contact us, you will speak directly with one of our experienced team members — not an answering service or call centre.

One of the most important differences in our care is that your loved one remains with us, in our care, at our own private mortuary care centre in Kyneton.

We do not outsource mortuary accommodation or preparation to external facilities. Your special person is cared for in our own beautifully appointed mortuary facilities by our experienced team, with dignity, respect and attention to detail at every stage. This continuity of care is deeply important to us and to many of the families we support.



Even when no viewing is requested, we believe proper care and preparation should never be considered an 'optional extra'. Every person entrusted to us is carefully washed, prepared, dressed and attended to as you would expect for someone important to your family. We understand that circumstances and emotions can change quickly, and families may later decide they would value the opportunity to spend time together and say goodbye.

Our professional service fees include many hours of arranging, coordination, preparation and personal support behind the scenes to ensure everything is cared for properly. This includes liaising with cemeteries, crematoriums, celebrants, florists, clergy, musicians, venues, printers and many other organisations on your behalf so that you are not left trying to manage these details alone.

All our professional service fees include the following standard inclusions:

- *Caring, experienced and professional staff available to support you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.*
- *Transfer of the person who has died into our care during normal business hours (Monday–Friday, 9am–5pm).*
(Additional fees apply for after-hours transfers or transfers outside our usual operating area (detailed fees on page 33))
- *Personal arrangement meetings and ongoing guidance throughout the organising process.*
- *Coordination and organisation of the funeral service, gathering or farewell, including the many administrative, logistical and legislative requirements involved.*
- *Care and preparation within our own mortuary care facilities in Kyneton, including washing, dressing, casketing, hairstyling and presentation as required.*
(Additional mortuary requests such as re-dressing may incur an additional fee.)
- *Private arrangement and consultation facilities in Kyneton, Gisborne and Kilmore.*
- *Viewing facilities during normal business hours at the Thomas J Scott Memorial Chapel in Kyneton.*
- *Use of our hearse (excluding the Chapel Farewell Option and no service options where no hearse is required).*
- *Preparation and lodgement of all necessary burial, cremation and registration documentation.*
- *Our online Tribute memorial page where family and friends can share funeral details, photographs, memories and messages of condolence.*
- *Staff attendance to the memorial book table (if attendance book requested).*
- *Guidance for family or friends acting as coffin bearers.*



- Assistance with music selection and preparation using our music library or downloaded selections.
- Guidance with service planning, readings, booklet wording and farewell structure whenever needed.
- Coordination of third-party services including celebrants, clergy, cemeteries, crematoriums, newspaper notices, flowers, refreshments, printing, music and audio-visual requirements.

Importantly, we do not add commissions or hidden surcharges to third-party expenses, and we do not receive incentives for recommending suppliers. Our professional fee includes the time, experience and care involved in organising these services on your behalf.

We believe transparency is important. All prices quoted already include GST and we will explain costs clearly before the funeral takes place, so you feel informed and comfortable with every decision made.

Our professional fee excludes:

- After-Hours Funerals & After-Hours Transfers
- After-Hours Viewings, Rosaries and Vigils
- Weekend or public holiday fees
- Additional vehicles
- Payment to third parties (as described)
- Travel outside our usual operating area (which includes Macedon Ranges Shire as well as Sunbury, Kilmore, Wallan and Broadford)
- Embalming (required for overseas repatriation and other situations).

Additional Services available

There are many ways to personalise a farewell and we offer a range of additional services and keepsakes to help create something meaningful and reflective of the person being remembered. These include:

- Embalming services by a qualified embalmer when requested or required.
- Printed materials such as service programs, mass booklets, bookmarks and thank you cards.
- Additional vehicles including family sedans and limousines.
- Visual tribute presentations and audio-visual support.
- Memorial and attendance books.
- Keepsake boxes, jewellery, photo frames and collage displays.

If there is something special you would like included, please speak with us — we are here to help create a farewell that feels personal and meaningful for your family.

Professional Service Options

Our professional service options are designed to give you choice and flexibility. We understand that every family, every person and every farewell is different — from a simple private cremation through to a large and highly personalised Celebration of Life, and everything in between.

All our professional service options include the care of the person who has died from the initial transfer into our care through to the day of the funeral or farewell itself. This includes the many hours of arranging, preparation, coordination and guidance required behind the scenes, along with all necessary administrative and legislative requirements.

Most importantly, our fees reflect the personal care and professional support provided by our experienced team — available 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

Wherever possible, you will have one dedicated Funeral Arranger supporting you throughout the process, ensuring continuity of care and personal attention during an important and emotional time.

The difference between the service options below generally reflects the level of time, staffing, travel and attendance required to organise and conduct the funeral itself.



SIGNATURE FAREWELL OPTION

\$8,820.00

A fully personalised farewell with complete flexibility and dedicated full-day care

Our Signature Farewell Service is designed for families who would like the flexibility, time and support to create a highly personalised farewell without feeling rushed or restricted by timing.

This service allows our team to dedicate the entire day exclusively to your family, with up to 5 staff allocated to attend to every detail of the funeral, gathering and committal. Because the day is reserved solely for your service, you may choose the timing that best suits your family rather than working within standard scheduling limitations. (Standard service timing is 10.30am or 2.30pm)

This option is often selected for larger funerals, services held in the middle of the day, gatherings requiring extensive venue preparation, or farewells involving multiple locations, refreshments between the service and committal, or separate private family moments throughout the day.

Where required, we include additional staff, vehicles and equipment for coffin bearing and cemetery lowering devices (where available) to make the day as seamless and supported as possible for your family.

We allow up to 8 hours on the funeral day itself, ensuring there is time to pause, gather, reflect and farewell without feeling hurried.

EXTENDED CARE SERVICE OPTION

\$7,785.00

Greater flexibility, additional support across multiple gatherings or locations

The Extended Care Service is designed for families who would appreciate additional flexibility and time beyond a traditional funeral structure. Many families choose this option when they would prefer refreshments in between the main service and the burial or cremation— whether later that day, earlier in the morning, or even on another day entirely. This allows time for family & friends to connect between gatherings without feeling pressured by immediate travel to the cemetery or crematorium.

Some families also prefer a smaller private committal attended only by immediate family and close friends, while others require additional travel time for services outside our local area.

This option allows our team additional time for travel, preparation, coordination and attendance, ensuring every part of the farewell is conducted with care and without compromise to service standards.

The Extended Care Service is also ideal for families who would like the service held outside our usual operating area (e.g.: Service in Melbourne, Moe, Wangaratta)

PERSONALISED CARE SERVICE**\$6,995.00*****A personalised farewell experience with caring professional support***

Our Personalised Care Service is designed for families wanting a meaningful and well-supported farewell within a traditional funeral timeframe.

This option includes a service at a venue of your choice — including the Thomas J. Scott Memorial Chapel — followed immediately by either:

- an attended burial or cremation committal, or*
- a non-attended cremation following the conclusion of the service.*

Some families may also choose to hold the entire farewell at a Crematorium

Chapel. Even when a funeral is relatively simple in structure, significant preparation, coordination and attendance time is required behind the scenes.

We allow up to 4 hours on the funeral day itself to ensure your service is properly prepared and conducted with care and attention to detail.

For this reason, our preferred service times are generally 10:30am or 2:30pm, allowing appropriate time between services and ensuring every family receives the attention they deserve.

If you would prefer additional time between the service and committal, or greater flexibility across multiple locations or days, our Extended Care Service may be more suitable.

CHAPEL FAREWELL OPTION**\$6,575.00*****A simpler chapel farewell held entirely at the Thomas J Scott Memorial Chapel***

The Chapel Farewell Option is designed for families who would prefer to hold the entire farewell within the comfort of the Thomas J Scott Memorial Chapel, without the need for a cortege or hearse attendance.

This option provides a simpler and more intimate funeral experience, with the service held entirely within the chapel before a non-attended cremation takes place later.

As the hearse is not present, there is no formal departure procession from the chapel. If you would prefer the hearse to depart following the service, our Personalised Care Service would apply.

This option is often chosen by families wanting a warm, meaningful and well-supported chapel farewell in a more contained setting.

THE COMMITTAL FAREWELL

\$6,380.00

A graveside farewell held entirely at the cemetery

The Committal Farewell is a service held entirely at the cemetery or burial place selected by the family.

This option is often chosen when a smaller, more informal or simpler farewell feels most appropriate. While the gathering may be simpler in structure, it can still include many meaningful and personal elements such as music, flowers, service programs and shared tributes.

We allow time for preparation of the graveside area, gathering of family and friends and the service itself, with up to 2 hours allocated on the day.

A cortege to the cemetery is not included in this option.

If the cemetery is located outside our usual local area, additional travel charges may apply to ensure sufficient time is allocated for staff travel and preparation.

THE CELEBRATION & REFLECTION FAREWELL

\$6,895.00

A memorial gathering held without the coffin present

The Celebration & Reflection Farewell is a memorial-style gathering held after a private cremation or burial has already taken place.

This option allows family and friends to come together to reflect, share stories, celebrate a life and acknowledge the significance of the person being remembered — without the coffin present at the gathering itself.

Many families appreciate the flexibility this provides, particularly when additional time is needed to plan a more personal gathering, when family are travelling, or when a less formal atmosphere is preferred.

We coordinate and attend to the many details involved, including celebrants, music, flowers, venue arrangements, refreshments, visual tributes and audio-visual requirements, ensuring the gathering feels thoughtful, organised and meaningful.

****Your selection of coffin & all third-party costs are additional.***



When someone says, 'I don't want a funeral' or 'I don't want a fuss', it is often said with love — in the hope of making things easier for family and friends. Sometimes families may also be navigating complicated circumstances, distance or family tensions that make a larger public gathering feel difficult.

Even so, many families later tell us how valuable it was to have some opportunity — however small or informal — to spend time together, acknowledge the significance of the person who has died and quietly say goodbye in their own way.

For this reason, we offer two simpler farewell options.

*The first is our **Family Gathering Option**, which provides a gentle and private opportunity for immediate family and close friends to come together without the formality or expectations of a traditional funeral service.*

*The second is our **Essential Option**, where there is no gathering or attendance and the cremation is attended privately by our team on your behalf.*

Both options honour the wishes of those who prefer simplicity, while allowing families to choose the level of farewell that feels right and most comfortable for them.



FAMILY GATHERING OPTION – ALL INCLUSIVE – \$7,975.00

+ Administration Fee of \$300 - deducted when paid prior to cremation

A quiet and private opportunity to gather together and say goodbye

The Family Gathering Option provides a simple and deeply personal opportunity for immediate family and close friends to spend quiet time together in farewell, without the formality of a traditional funeral service.

Held privately at the Thomas J Scott Memorial Chapel, this gathering is not publicly advertised and attendance is limited to up to 30 family members and close friends. The atmosphere is relaxed and informal — families are welcome to sit together, share stories, play meaningful background music, display favourite photographs and simply spend time together in whatever way feels most natural and comforting. There is no formal service structure, celebrant, eulogies or expectations around 'how' the gathering should unfold. Instead, this option creates space for families to farewell the person they love quietly and personally, without the pressure often associated with a larger public funeral.

One member of our team will be present to gently welcome and support your family throughout the gathering and coordinate the arrangements for you.

Following the gathering, the cremation is attended to privately by T J Scott & Son on your behalf.

Many families choose this option when they wish to honour someone's request for "no fuss", while still recognising the importance of having a small and meaningful opportunity to come together and say goodbye.

This option is available Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays (excluding periods adjoining public holidays) at a time coordinated around our chapel services.

If you would prefer a more structured farewell involving larger attendance numbers, livestreaming, printed service materials, visual tributes, formal music coordination or a more organised order of proceedings, our Chapel Farewell Service may be more suitable.

This all-inclusive fee includes:

- *Transfer into our care (during normal hours within our local area)*
- *Mortuary care and preparation*
- *Chapel gathering time*
- *Cremation fee*
- *Required certificates and registrations*
- *Mileage to the crematorium*
- *Our Lyell Coffin -Veneered coffin in a light maple finish*
- *Official Death Certificate Package ordered on your behalf*



ESSENTIAL CARE OPTION – ALL INCLUSIVE - \$5,625.00
+ Administration Fee of \$300 - deducted when paid prior to cremation

A private cremation attended to entirely by our team

The Essential Care Option, also known as a Direct cremation, is the simplest funeral arrangement available and does not include a funeral gathering, service or family attendance.

Your loved one is cared for privately by our team, with the cremation taking place at a time coordinated by our funeral directors without mourners present.

This option is often chosen when families would prefer no gathering at all, when arrangements need to remain very simple, or when a farewell may take place privately at another time or in another way.

Although there is no formal service, every person entrusted to our care is still prepared and attended to with dignity and respect within our own mortuary care facilities in Kyneton.

This all-inclusive fee includes:

- *Transfer into our care (during normal hours within our local area)*
- *Mortuary care and preparation*
- *Viewing for immediate family*
- *Required registrations and documentation*
- *Cremation fee at Bendigo*
- *Mileage to the crematorium*
- *Our Tasman (coffin shaped receptacle which is unveneered)*
- *Attendance to the cremation by our staff*
- *Official Death Certificate Package is ordered on your behalf*

If you feel you may benefit from even a small private opportunity to gather with close family or friends before the cremation takes place, we encourage you to consider our Family Gathering Option, which provides a gentle and informal space to say goodbye without the structure of a traditional funeral service.



THE LIVING WAKE OPTION with Private Cremation**\$9,795.00*****A Living Wake – Celebrating Life Together***

For some people, the most meaningful farewell is one they can be part of themselves. A Living Wake offers the opportunity to gather family and friends together while the person at the centre of the celebration is still with us — to hear the stories, share the laughter, receive the love and experience the impact they have had on the lives around them.

Rather than waiting until after someone has died to speak the words we wish we had said, a Living Wake creates the space to say them now. It can be a deeply uplifting and memorable occasion where memories are shared directly with the person who inspired them — allowing gratitude, love, humour and acknowledgement to be experienced together.

A Living Wake does not need to feel formal or traditional. For many, it takes on a more relaxed and personal atmosphere — perhaps held at home, in a garden, winery, hall, favourite venue or family property. Some families choose a casual gathering with refreshments, music and photographs, while others include speeches, tributes, visual presentations, storytelling, live music or special acknowledgements. It may feel more like a celebration, dinner party or gathering of favourite people than a traditional funeral service.

Most importantly, it is about creating time together. Time to reconnect. Time to reflect. Time to honour someone's life while they are still here to feel surrounded by the people they love and the stories they helped create.

Many families still choose to hold a small private farewell, essential cremation or quiet committal when the time comes, however the main celebration of life has already been shared together — openly, personally and meaningfully.

At T J Scott & Son, we can help guide and coordinate a Living Wake that feels comfortable, personal and reflective of the person being honoured — creating a farewell filled not only with sadness, but also gratitude, connection and joy.

**All third-party costs for the Living Wake gathering such as Venue fees, audio visual costs, flowers and catering are additional. Included in our Living Wake Option is the Essential Care Option - when death occurs, we will then quietly and professionally attend to the arrangements for a direct cremation. (See description)*



MEMORIAL SERVICE ONLY

\$ 4,150.00

(Burial or Cremation has been attended to elsewhere)

When the burial or cremation has already taken place (interstate or overseas), a Memorial Service provides an opportunity for family and friends to gather together to reflect, share memories and celebrate a life. We coordinate and attend to the memorial gathering for you, including assistance with celebrants, music, notices, flowers or décor, visual tributes, audio-visual requirements and refreshments.

Included is our online *Tributes & Reflections* memorial page.

All third-party costs are additional.

EXHUMATION FEE

\$ 9,995.00

The Exhumation fee is for the organising and completion of an Exhumation from one cemetery to another. Once the License for Exhumation has been granted to the Executor/s we organise the exhumation to take place, the transfer of the remains to the selected grave/cemetery and the burial of the exhumed remains. At least two staff are allocated and an exhumation can take up to 8 hours on the day. If a two-day exhumation is required additional fees would apply. Exhumation Licence and other Third-Party Costs are additional.

REPATRIATION (Interstate)

\$ 5,895.00

Organising Repatriation Interstate includes transfer from the place of death during normal business hours, mortuary care and preparation for transport (including embalming where required), and a basic unveneered Tasman coffin suitable for road or air transfer. The fee also includes completion of the necessary administration and registrations, coordination of required documentation, and liaison with the family representative or receiving funeral director to arrange transport to the destination. Death Certificate, air freight or road transport costs, and other third-party expenses are additional.

REPATRIATION (Overseas)

\$ 8,895.00

Organising Repatriation Overseas includes transfer from the place of death during normal business hours (after-hours transfers additional), mortuary care and required embalming, preparation for air transport, the statutory documentation required for overseas transfer, and coordination with the family representative or receiving funeral director. The fee also includes the basic metal air transport container, completion of death registration and administration, and arranging the necessary overseas documentation and transport coordination. Death Certificate, air freight charges and other third-party costs are additional.



EMBALMING (Cost depends on service required)**\$ POA**

Embalming is optional but it is extremely effective as it *sanitises* –by reducing bacteria and odours, it *preserves* (by slowing the rate of deterioration and making viewing possible for a longer period) and *aesthetically*, it helps enormously by giving a natural colour to your loved one. We can offer this professional service with an experienced and qualified embalmer, as we want your loved one to look their best.

ADDITIONAL MORTUARY REQUESTS**\$ 385.00**

While our Mortuary Care is included in our professional fees to prepare, wash, dress and attend to the deceased for viewings, families may request additional care or time for their loved one while with us. This may include things like re-dressing the deceased after initial care has been completed or family dressing when the chapel space is required for more than an hour.

PROVIDING OWN COFFIN - HANDLING FEE**\$ 345.00**

-includes legalisation of Nameplate. Indemnity must be provided

Families choosing to supply their own coffin or casket must arrange delivery to our premises at least 3 days prior to the funeral so it can be assessed for compliance with Victorian Cemeteries & Crematoria Regulations and, most importantly, to ensure the safety, suitability and dignity of care for the person who has died, as well as the safety of those required to carry or handle the coffin. An indemnity form and proof of public liability insurance are required prior to acceptance. Most importantly, these requirements exist to safeguard the dignity, care and safety of the person being entrusted to us, as well as those handling the coffin. They also reflect the professional standards, quality materials and workmanship we stand behind in every coffin and casket we supply. (for full description see page 26)

Our pricing reflects not only the quality and craftsmanship of each coffin or casket, but also the level of care, preparation and presentation involved. As the craftsmanship and detailing increase, we work to keep our pricing balanced so families can access premium options without disproportionate cost increases.

Many families find their choice within our *Classic & Personal Collection*, as it offers a thoughtful balance of style, quality and value. Others may feel drawn to something more natural, contemporary or individually crafted. All coffins and caskets in our range are fully lined and comply with the Cemeteries & Crematoria Regulations Victoria 2005. The handles, hardware, ornaments and engraved nameplate shown (or the closest available alternative) are included in the listed price.



Please note that if larger dimensions than standard sizing are required to ensure the appropriate comfort and care of the person in our care, an additional charge may apply depending on the coffin or casket selected. We will always discuss this with you openly and sensitively should this be necessary.

SUPPLYING YOUR OWN COFFIN OR CASKET

Own Coffin Handling Fee —

\$ 345.00

Includes legalisation of the required Nameplate. Indemnity documentation required.

Occasionally, families choose to provide their own coffin or casket, particularly when it has been personally handcrafted or holds special meaning for the person who has died. We have seen some deeply personal examples over the years, including coffins made from timber gathered on a family property or lined with wool from a family farm — thoughtful touches that became a meaningful part of the farewell.

If you wish to supply your own coffin or casket, it must be delivered to our premises at least 3 days prior to the funeral so it can be assessed for compliance with Victorian Cemeteries & Crematoria Regulations and, most importantly, to ensure appropriate dignity, comfort and safety for the person in our care and for those required to lift or carry the coffin, including family members and our staff.

Please note that some imported or privately purchased coffins may not meet Australian standards for strength, construction or hardware reliability. We have unfortunately seen handles and fittings fail under weight, creating distress and potential safety risks. For this reason, we can only accept coffins or caskets that meet the professional standards required for funeral use in Australia. All coffins and caskets supplied through our firm are sourced through trusted Australian manufacturers (with the exception of the premium legacy Tribute range from Canada) and are selected for their quality workmanship, compliant materials and safe handling standards — standards we confidently stand behind for every family we serve.

Proof of purchase and, in some circumstances, certification confirming compliance with Australian standards may be required. An indemnity form and evidence of public liability insurance must also be provided prior to acceptance. Supplied coffins or caskets cannot be altered or modified by our staff in any way, and we reserve the right to refuse to lift or carry any coffin or casket we believe may present a safety risk.

These requirements are not intended to make the process difficult, but rather to ensure the highest standards of dignity, care and safety for the person entrusted to us, and for every family member and staff member involved in the farewell.



Additional Options and Third-Party Fees

The following services are listed to give you further information about the various cremation and burial options available.

As each Cemetery and Crematorium have their own unique fees, we suggest you go to their website to check current costs as they can change at any time. It is impossible to list all the options available but we are happy to find out any costs for you for any cemetery or crematorium – please advise us of your preferred option and we can provide costings for you.

Cremation Fees

Crematoriums are located in Bendigo, Fawkner, Altona, Springvale, Ballarat, Lilydale, Bunurong and Geelong and each has different fees.

As we are based in the Macedon Ranges, a Crematorium Transfer fee of **\$595** is applicable to Fawkner or Bendigo on the day of the funeral to personally attend to the cremation. Mileage to Springvale, Altona, Bunurong, Lilydale or Geelong is approx. **\$625**. We do not use crematorium transport or bulk interstate cremation services.

Burial Fees

Every cemetery in Victoria has different fees and different options within their cemetery. It is a very important decision, and we would recommend a visit to the cemetery of your choice to help you make that decision. Some cemeteries will prepare a triple depth grave, but most will prepare to a double depth (room for two interments only). Please speak with us if you have a particular cemetery in mind and we can get the options and costs for you, or alternatively we can give you the contact details to meet with the cemetery personnel at the selected cemetery.

Venues

Celebrant

If you choose to have a celebrant their fees can range from \$330 for a religious minister, approx. \$500 for a catholic priest and approx. \$700 to \$900 for a funeral celebrant. The choice of celebrant is an important one and may depend on where the service or gathering will be held. Whether it be a funeral celebrant, minister or priest we will liaise with them to help co-ordinate the entire service.

Flowers

Flowers are often ordered to be placed on the coffin and they are such an individual choice. You may prefer to make or provide something yourselves or we can order something for you. To give you an estimate, our local florists make beautiful standard casket sheafs starting at \$450. Baskets of Petals for the graveside start at \$50 or you may like to supply rosemary or greenery from your own garden.



Music

Music is such an important element of a gathering and an important part of the funeral to think about. We can organise live musicians, organists and recorded music for you. Included in our professional fees is access to our extensive music library and we can help you put together a play list of recorded music if that is your preference.

Notices

We can insert death and funeral notices into local, metropolitan, interstate or international publications for you. To give you an idea, the average size of a funeral or a death notice in the Herald-Sun is 4cm. Please check current costs per cm with your funeral arranger.

Death Certificate – We can order a ‘Death Certificate Package’ from the Registry of Births, Deaths & Marriages Vic (BDM) on your behalf once the funeral has taken place. This includes a standard death certificate with the cause of death & a death certificate without the cause of death to protect your family’s privacy. This is issued directly to the Informant. If you only require the full (Standard) Death Certificate (Includes the cause of death) please advise and only one certificate will be requested.

Cremation Certificate

When a cremation is requested, we must organise for an independent Medical Practitioner to complete a certificate authorising the cremation to take place. This is required by every crematorium for the cremation to take place. The doctor attends our chapel in Kyneton to complete this and the standard fee is \$95.00.

Cremated Remains

The cremated remains (ashes) of your loved one can be collected directly from the crematorium as soon as 2 working days following the day of cremation. Please contact the crematorium if you wish to do so.

Alternatively, we can personally collect the cremated remains from the crematorium on our next visit and return them to our Kyneton office for you to collect from there. This service is provided at no additional cost however the timing does depend on when we are next going to the crematorium so if you would prefer them back by a specific time, please organise this directly with the selected Crematorium.



Memorial Urns, Keepsakes & Memorial Jewellery

There are many options with cremated remains including placing them in an urn, memorialisation at a cemetery or other venue, scattering or placing some in memorial jewellery. If you need some guidance, please don't hesitate to contact us.

Sharing Memories

Our 'A Life Remembered' books are a beautiful way for those attending to record and share a favourite story, memory or message for your loved one. For just \$69 we can have this on the memorial book table with a sign inviting people to contribute. We suggest you nominate a family member or friend to take this around during refreshments also and invite people to share something at that time. It is a very special keepsake.

Visual Tributes

Sharing photos of your loved one during the funeral is a very special way to pay tribute and remember some moments in time. We have professional Audio-Visual specialists we can recommend putting these together for you or you may prefer to organise something yourself.

The most important thing to remember is that visual tributes take time. Allow 3-5 days before the funeral (depending on size and quantity of photos). Firstly select the photos you wish to include and then these images need to be uploaded into a professional program which creates a visual tribute that is perfectly timed to the music you select. We then test the presentation the day before the service to ensure everything will run smoothly on the day. Packages start for as little as \$250 depending on supplier, number of photos and length of music.

If you would prefer to put your own photo presentation together, please ensure this is tested on the equipment to be used at the service, at least one day prior to the day to confirm that your presentation can be played and is compatible with that particular venue system. If there are any issues there is then time to rectify them. These presentations are too important to leave to chance and even people who are very tech-savvy can have difficulty creating a visual tribute, with the correct menu, which is compatible with most systems -so it is worth the check.

If you need assistance with conversion of files so that it is compatible, the Audio-Visual company will need your slideshow and music at least 2 days prior, to have time to organise for it to be converted to a compatible file with a menu system. A menu ensures the presentation doesn't 'switch off' during the service. It is a safeguard for the day itself if needed.



Visual Tributes are usually around 3-8 minutes in length starting with approx. 40 photos with one piece of recorded music for a basic version. Costs increase depending on the number of photos and songs and if high resolution scanning is required. If video footage is to be included, please advise your consultant and they will advise the extra cost.

Audio Visual Equipment Hire

Not all venues have audio visual equipment in-house. Once you have decided on the venue for the funeral, we will advise you what/ if any equipment is included at the venue itself. One of the most important parts of a funeral is that everyone, if possible, can hear the service and see the Visual Tribute. People who come along appreciate being part of the service and being able to hear the stories, so ensuring appropriate A/V equipment is provided is important.

We provide one portable speaker with IPAD & USB functionality, as well as a microphone with stand and lectern at no additional cost if there is nothing available. This system, being portable, is recommended for smaller venues only.

In addition to this basic audio equipment, we can provide the following visual option for you:

Projector, screen and audio speakers for the playing of Visual Tributes during the service is **\$595.00**.

This fee includes set up and operation by a member of our staff and is perfect for smaller services & venues.

When a large number of people will be attending, we recommend audio visual equipment suitable for that environment. We can assist you in organising hire through specialist providers when requested and would recommend professional equipment with excellent sound quality wherever possible.

Cost will depend on equipment required and we can get quotations for you prior to booking.



Filming of the Service & Live Streaming

We can organise livestreaming and recording of the funeral service / gathering. This allows for family and friends who are unable to be present to be part of the farewell – wherever they may be.

Due to the uncertainty of internet capability in certain parts of the Macedon Ranges and Mitchell Shire these companies will record the service and, if there are any interruptions or loss of connectivity during the service, they will upload to the site as soon as possible after the service is concluded.

Some families simply choose to have the funeral filmed so that they have a record of what was said and by whom. This can be of particular significance if there are young children in the family who may need to, at a later time, share what was said at their close family member's service.

Many civic & private venues require the hirer (the family) to set-up and pack down the venue (i.e. set up chairs, arrange furniture, sweep and clean and remove rubbish on exit). If you would prefer, we can complete the set up and pack down for you. An additional charge of **\$550.00** is applicable.

Catering

We can assist with booking your chosen catering venue. Please note: Bar tabs cannot be included on the funeral invoice and would be paid directly by Next Of Kin (NOK) on the day. Please advise dietary requirements.

The **Caroline Room** is available for hire at the Thomas J Scott Memorial Chapel as a refreshment space following a chapel funeral (only available when the service is in the Thomas J Scott Chapel) for \$335. Catering is additional. (Cost will depend on supplier) Suits up to 45 guests.

Administration Fee:

The Administration Fee of \$300 can be deducted from the account if the balance is paid in full prior to the day of the funeral. This fee relates to the cost of recovering late payments.

Please note that an overdue account fee of \$50 per month is charged on all overdue accounts exceeding these payment terms.

The total funeral costs generally include a combination of services we provide directly, along with third-party expenses that we organise and manage on your behalf. The person who authorises the funeral by signing the Funeral Service Agreement is financially responsible for the funeral expenses. We also ask that a second person be nominated as an additional contact for any follow-up regarding the account if needed.

Please note that payment of funeral expenses is not dependent on the outcome of any insurance, Workcover, or estate matters. These claims are processed separately, and the relevant authority will reimburse the person who has paid the funeral invoice. We're happy to provide paid invoices promptly to assist you in submitting any claims.

Our pricing is based on services held during standard business hours, Monday to Friday. Additional fees apply for services, viewings, or gatherings held after hours on weekends or public holidays. If you have any questions or would like to talk through the details, please don't hesitate to speak with us—we're here to help.

Payments can be paid by Cash, Cheque, EFTPOS or by EFT (Direct Credit). Credit Card payments incur a 1% fee. Please speak with your funeral arranger if you need any further information.
